### ABOUT THE WINE

Malbec, but classic, OG, French style Malbec, is what we have lined up for you this month. Though Malbec is synonymous with Argentina, it's actually from Southwestern France and still has a home there in the appellation of Cahors. Cahors' Malbecs tend to have brighter acidity and a less ripe fruit profile than their Argentinian counterparts. The herby peppery profile is also more notable in this bottle. Château Gaudou is a 17th century estate with old vines between the ages of 30 and 120 years that are farmed organically with no intervention in the winery except for a tiny bit of added sulfur for stabilization. This Malbec is a true delight and a fun wine to show how different a grape can taste in different terroirs!

Nice tart fruity palate, with a pleasant spicy finish.
