ABOUT THE WINE

“Bojan Kobal – by day winemaker at Pullus Winery, by night he is making Kobal wines at his family’s winery located in Bizljelso, located some 30 minutes outside of town Ptuj. Kobal is a tiny garage winery, Bojan’s passion for some unique grape varieties.

Blaufränkisch is mostly grown in Austria, carries a German-language name, and even on the label of this Slovenian wine bears this same German-language moniker, the origins of Blaufränkisch have never been conclusively proven to be rooted in Austria, and indeed the Slovenians have their own local name for this vine – Frankovna Crna – so it is entirely possible that Slovenia could be this dark and vivacious red variety’s home.”- NovoVino Wine Co., Importer

It’s honest, bright, and while fruity, it has a depth and a deeply earthy backbone to it that draws us back for more and more.
