### ABOUT THE WINE

New year, new us, new good wine to discover, enjoy and share! If you're going dry, damp (like us, moderation is king for our new year) or staying fully wet this January we're in full support of your new start to the year. We've got some fire wines to kick off the new year though, whenever you decide to crack them!

This stunning Sicilian white/orangish wine is bodied and radiant on the palate and everything we want to kick off our new year. Cantina Marilina started with Sicilian winemaker Angelo Paternò, who had been lending his talents to other local wineries for years. He bought and settled into the estate considering it one of the best sites in Sicily to grow vines. Since then, his daughters Marilina and Federica have taken over, while Angelo still advises in the cellar. This wine is insanely complex, rich and flirts with an orange style, with a bit of skin-contact in the winemaking process.

A rich bowl full of lemon and orange zest, dried apricots, and notes of chamomile and saline.
