## ABOUT THE WINE

Song: "Red Wine Supernova" (Chappell Roan)

"I just wanna get to know ya  
Guess I didn't quite think it through (nah-uh, girl)  
Fell in love with the thought of you  
Now I'm choked up, face down, burnt out  
Baby, why don't you come over?  
Red wine supernova, falling into me  
(Let's pick it up now)

This one of a kind red from Divisions, means "west" and is meant as an homage to the spirit of the winemaking traditions of the Pacific Northwest. It features three grapes we've never seen together, one from Northern Italy in Piedmont (Nebbiolo), one from Central Italy in Tuscany (Sangiovese), and one from Southern France (Syrah), and somehow these grapes grown in the new world terroir of the PNW play perfectly together. They all tend to be grapes with an earthy and savory backbone with high-toned perfumed characters and have varying levels of body (Nebbiolo- light, Sangio- medium, Syrah- full) which when blended balances out perfectly! We've been trying to get to know her since we first tasted her a few weeks ago and to say we're obsessed is an understatement. This wine is for sure our Red Wine Supernova of the summer and that's something we're not at all mad about!

A unique blend of three classic red grapes; two from Italy one from France. Bold but not overpowering with flavors and aromas of herbs, smoked meats, purple and red flowers and dark berries.
