ABOUT THE WINE

2024 kicks off with a wine club perennial favorite, Domaine Jean-Pascal Aubron. Since his wines hit the market here in Ohio in 2022, we’ve had three different versions of this Melon de Bourgogne wines in wine club. In 2022 we kicked it off strong with his skin-contact version of the grape, then in 2023 we were floored by his white wine version of the grape, and now in 2024 we’re stoked about his pet-nat of the same grape. The versatility of the grape is astounding as each wine tastes and exhibits such different characteristics on the visuals and palate. Interestingly, even with the differences, some aspects remain the same due to the natural characteristic of the grape and terroir that tie each cuvee together, like a minerally profile of what is often described as wet rocks or even oyster shells. We are always impressed by the simplicity, yet precision of his wines and honestly thought what better way to start the year than with some bubbles. This wine goes great with everything from brunch (you could definitely make some mean mimosas with this or drink it as-is) to salads, seafood, or just hanging with friends.

Crisp and refreshing notes of lemon, apple and the unmistakable earthy wet rock and oyster shell like flavors of the region.
