We all know sometimes two is better than one; especially when they complement and contrast each other perfectly. This dreamy Italian white gets its zest and pep from a unique and spot-on blending of Cortese (a local Piedmontese grape) and Chardonnay. Cortese gives a lean, acidic, minerally yin to Chardonnay's round, tree-fruited and slightly creamy yang. Birds of a feather, sticking together, and each, surprisingly, better together than alone. We could and probably will be enjoying this harmonious blend with this poppy yet soulful ballad the rest of the summer!
