The year without their wines felt like forever so when we heard they were coming back we knew we wanted to share their sublime portfolio with you via a wine club takeover! They focus on "authentic wines by authentic people" (aka au naturel) and started working with Spanish producers, then added wine from Latin America, and now Portugal. In addition to stocking their wines, we also currently have a nice selection of Spanish conserva (tinned fish and seafood) curated and imported by them, and some delicious organic canned cocktails on our menu! This month we decided to focus on one producer who is making some jaw droppingly stellar wines from Chile, Estacion Yumbel. We've queued up for you an insane orange wine and two wines of the grape País, that are great to try side by side to see how different terroirs and winemaking practices can influence each wine. We love Estacion Yumbel so much we're currently pouring another one of their País wines by the glass now, so stop in and try that one if you like the others.
