This beautifully aromatic and edgy wine from Iruai is inspired by the winemaker Chad Hinds love of the white wines of the Jura and Savoie regions nestled in the French Alps. They're bodied, complex, mineraly, and full of bright zesty acidity. We poured the previous vintage of this same wine on our tasting menu last year and it was a huge hit. The new vintage arrived this past week and we thought it was a no-brainer to roll it out with a wine club debut! They describe this wine like, "Imagine dropping a Ricola (or a shot of chartreuse) into a margarita and setting off in a canoe," and we could not be more down with that vibe! They also recommend it paired with the following:
