ABOUT THE WINE

We love a good wine collab; and Kiki and Juan is just that John ("Juan" in Spanish). House of Ovum wines based out of Oregon and his business partner Kerin (Kiki) Auth Bemby first met on a bus in Spain in 2011 and bonded immediately over their mutual love of wine. They formed the wine import company La Luz Selections that focuses on working with partners in Spain who farm biodynamically, organically and focus on long term sustainability. They then decided why not have their own line, so Kiki and Juan's wines were born! For this collaboration they teamed up with Utiel Requena, a Spanish farmer, based in Valencia. Utiel farms the grapes and John makes the wines. So far they have three cuvees; a white, a red, both in liter format, and this orange, which blew our socks off the first time we tried it. It's quite complex and layered yet still accessible enough to be enjoyed with almost any food; or without it!

Tangerine and almond notes are followed by a herbaceous savory finish on this Spanish beauty.
