We're so stoked to have another super rare wine lined up for y'all this month! What we received for wine club is half of what was available for the whole state of Ohio! No big deal- we're always scoring the best of the best for our wine club faithful! Importer Steven Graf describes La Grange Aux Belles as a "cadre of friends making wine in Anjou". They work on the black schist soils that are different than what the region is known for and considered more austere, which could help promote grape development. They're also meticulous pickers and can easily make up to 5 passes in the vineyard, picking and sorting at each grape's perfect ripeness. Their wines are precise and electric and this Pinot d'Aunis is perfect for the Turkey Day table with its medium body and perfect balance of fruit and earthy characteristics.

Spiced with herbal notes that go so well with the tart berry finish.
