ABOUT THE WINE

Who’s ready to party?! Ross and Bee Maloof know how to get it started for sure with their killer wines including this stunner that floats between the boundaries of wine styles:

“This is sort of a ‘rosé’ for us. As you’ll see on the back of the bottle it states ‘rose-ish’. We wanted to have the playfulness and functionality of a rosé without actually using any red fruit. Whether you call it white wine, orange wine, or rose, Where ya PJs at?, cause this thing is a slumber party!”

The pinkish (rosé-ish, if you will) hue comes from the skins of the Pinot Gris and Schönburger grapes that are both usually made into white wines, but the skins from both of them look more like red wine grapes. Boldly aromatic and dangerously chuggable this wine is definitely one to pop at a party, even if it’s just a party for two!

Blood Orange meets red berries with a minerally backbone.
