ABOUT THE WINE

Pisador comes from “pisar” the Spanish verb to step on, it means “foot-trodden”, like the grapes in the bottle. First, they were picked by hand and then stomped by foot before becoming the delicious wine we get to share with you. Pisador is the super small production project of Elena Pantaleoni of La Stoppa Wines (Emilia-Romagna, Italy) and Nicola Massa, a friend of Elena’s from the wine industry. Elena’s mother had been living in Chile several decades when the idea to make wine in Chile too struck her. They wanted to make a style of País that was unlike the traditional Chilean style of Pipeño, which is easy drinking and juicy, instead they wanted to produce bold and complex País and that they did. Insanely complex yet still of the earth in flavor and by craft. We hope you love Elena and Nicola’s wine as much as we do!
