### ABOUT THE WINE

Disco is back, baby, and we’re here for the renaissance in disco tunes as well as this super fun and one-of-a-kind expression of Sauvy B, from one of our go-to producers, Subject to Change Wine Co. Coming from grapes planted in the 70s, quite appropriate for the name, this wine was made with a unique winemaking process that utilizes both carbonic maceration and a method usually reserved for rosés called reverse saignée. The resulting wine is one that is complex in flavor but friendly on the palate, leading with fun fruity flavors with just the right amount of structure to have a pleasant lengthy finish but not take over everything. This wine is a go-to for us for parties! It’s a skin-contact wine (always fun to introduce friends to this style), the label is popping, and the wine carries this contagious energy that goes well to banging tunes and dance moves!
